| Entry fee | \$150 | \$150 |
| Canoe hire | from \$100 to 300 depending on the Quality of the boat subject to negotiation note some may be private boats loaned by NW Canoe club members*** | \$150 |
| Airfares | depends on when you book but probably \$800 to \$1000 return | \$900 |
| Accommodation | if you want to leave your camping gear behind and just take clothes and Canoe gear. Accommodation share rooms about \$150pp per night say 3 nights \$450 | \$450 |
| Food and sundries | I'm Guessing another \$250 | \$250 |
| Car hire | Depends on numbers and vehicles say \$200pp | \$200 |
| Mt Isa add-on | 1 night and day in Mt Isa sightseeing including mine tour and general sights seeing | \$350 |
